Ongoing projects

- E. coli/geese mitigation efforts
 - Good levels this year. Safe most of summer with two brief closures. In order to keep levels safe, county decided to euthanize geese due to low staffing and activity at the beach. Large amounts of feces removed and amount of geese was unsafe for people using the beach.
 - Reached out to county to see what planning can be done ahead of time for next year
 - Idea to re-landscape beach to deter geese in the future.
 - Weighing other options to keep beach safe while maintaining geese.
 - Reach out to Rice and Larpenteur project to include beach updates in project
 - Simple wire in front of water can deter geese in spring.
 - Focus on early spring to prevent geese from laying eggs
 - Muskrat Minute article to help residents with ideas to deter geese

Outlet Issues

 Ask community for volunteers to clear outlet one or two times this fall to help clear outlet to prevent lake from freezing at high levels and causing shoreline damage

Zebra Mussels research

Samplers to be removed this fall to document zebra mussel density

Water Guards and boat launch tools

- Ramsey county allocated 100 hours of water guards at the boat launch.
- Amy to contact water guards to see how many hours were actually used.
- New tools at launch to clear weeds from boats
- Amy to contact about some broken tools.

New business

- Buffer strip field burn of natural strip. Neighbors are interested in burning buffer strip- we might be able to coordinate for training or coordinated permitting
- Chris Galla to make article for Muskrat minute to encourage natural shoreline buffer.

Outreach from Ramsey County Health Department – update on project
